Dear Members,

We are pleased to share this good news from EOEA, that the assisted living visitation guidance will be modified effective September 25, allowing visitation in an indoor designated space. This will be particularly helpful to some member care providers and others who have not utilized in-unit visitation and were seeking options for indoor visitation in designated spaces. We will send an update with the full revised visitation guidance as soon as we receive it. The announcement from Patricia Marchetti is copied below.

I'm writing to share the following update with you regarding Indoor Visitation:

Consistent with the DPH long-term care facility visitation policy announced today, effective September 25, 2020, ALRs may additionally permit visitation in an indoor designated space. Please note that EOEA plans to provide an updated, consolidated Guidance Memorandum to you in a week to 10 days.
